GENERAL RULES

Registration and Weighing:

11:00 a.m. to 12:45 p.m.

Tractor Pull:

Starts at 1:00 p.m. Pit meeting held at 12:45 p.m. at the Grandstand

Antique tractors: must be 1967 and older.

Weight classes for antique tractors are:

4000 lbs

4500 lbs

5000 lbs

5500 lbs

6000 lbs

6500 lbs

7000 lbs

7500 lbs

8500 lbs

Speed limit: 4 mph for antique tractors. Torque amplifiers or TA's can be used. 10% over factory RPMs

<u>Out-of-the field tractors</u>: any age tractor. 6 mph. Weight classes for out-of-field tractors are:

9.500 lbs

10,500 lbs

11,500 to 12,500 lbs - 8 mph speed limit.

No DUAL wheels. Factory Turbo's only

Tire size for antique tractors:

- 0-4500 lbs: can use up to 13.6 X 38
- 4501-6500 lbs: can use up to 14.9 X 38
- · or 16.9 X 34
- · 7000-7500 lbs: can use 16.9 X 38
- 8500-10,500 lbs: can use 18.4 X 38
- 11,500-12,500 lbs: no tire restrictions

Weights:

- · Suitcase weights can be used
- Front weight brackets and weights to extend no further than 11 ft from the center of the rear axle.
- Antique Classes Rear weights not back from plane of rear tires.

Hitches:

- Minimum 18 in back from the center or the rear axle
- Maximum of 20 in drawbar height
- Pullers must use their own clevis.
